DATA PROTECTION POLICY: VMARS maintains and processes records of members' personal data in order to manage its affairs and to further the objectives of the society and its members. Its policy is not to release a member's personal data to third parties, except with that member's explicit consent. The membership list is circulated only to fellow members, on condition that it is not to be used for commercial purposes and is not passed to non-members. There is provision for members to withhold most details from publication, if they so wish. Note: your name and postal town will be published in the Society's News Sheet in all cases when you are introduced as a new member. You may only withhold these specific details from the annual membership list by making special application to the Membership Secretary in writing. For the purposes of the Data Protection Act, the Data Controller is the Vintage and Military Amateur Radio Society. All queries should be addressed, in the first instance, to the Membership Secretary.
